Create a Zoom meeting

- Open the Zoom app on your desktop and click Sign In
- Login with your credentials
- Click the downward arrow and select Start with video, then click New Meeting to start an instant meeting.

Join a Zoom meeting

Note: Each zoom meeting has a unique 9, 10, or 11-digit number called a meeting ID that will be required to join a Zoom meeting

- Click join a meeting if you want to join without signing or sign into Zoom and click join
- Enter the meeting ID number and your display name
 - o If you are signed in, you can change it if you don't want your default name to appear
 - If you are not signed in, enter a display name
- Select if you would like to connect with audio and/or video and click Join

- In the Zoom Client, click on the schedule icon
- Select your meeting settings
- Select schedule to finish and open the selected calendar service to add the meeting

Change Zoom Audio and Video Settings

- In the Zoom client application, select the Settings button to customize your preferences
- Under Audio Settings, you can modify the following:
- Change the default output. You can test your audio by selecting Test Speaker
- Change the default microphone. You can change this by selecting Test Mic

Under video settings, you can modify the following:

- Choose the camera you want to use from the Camera dropdown list
- Choose to capture HD video from your camera
- Enable mirror effect, this will reflect the camera's frame like you are looking in a mirror
- Choose to Always show name on video window, this will show your name to other participants
- Choose to turn off video when joining meetings, this will turn off video when joining meetings
- Choose to hide non-video participants, this will hide participants who have their video off
- Choose to spotlight video when you speak, this will bring attention to your video when you speak
